What is Safehome?

Safehome is a Queensland Fire and Emergency Services (QFES) program where firefighters will visit your home and help you to identify fire and safety hazards in and around the home. You can then take steps to eliminate those hazards. Firefighters will advise you on the correct positioning and installation of smoke alarms.

How much does it cost?

Safehome is a **FREE** service provided by QFES in the interest of developing a safer community where you will receive a safety pack which includes a checklist.

Who is Safehame available to?

All people who live in Queensland and are concerned with improving safety in their home.

What if I live in a rural area?

If you live in a rural area serviced by volunteer firefighters, a firefighter may not be able to visit your home. Instead you will receive a Safehome Kit and may be contacted about organising a bushfire property advice visit.

How long will a visit take?

All homes have different requirements but a visit should take no longer than 45 minutes.
