What is **safehome**?

Safehome is a program where firefighters will visit your home and help you identify fire and safety hazards. You can then make changes to remove those dangers. Firefighters will also advise you on the correct placement of smoke alarms and compliance with smoke alarm legislation in Queensland.

How much does it cost?

Safehome is a **FREE** service. You will receive a visit and a Safehome Kit to help you prepare your home.

Who can have a visit?

All Queensland residents.

What if I live in a rural area?

If you live in a rural area serviced by volunteer firefighters, a firefighter may not be able to visit your home. Instead you will receive a Safehome Kit and may be contacted about arranging a bushfire property advice visit.

How long will a visit take?

All homes are different but a visit should take no more than 45 minutes.
