In an emergency like a bushfire, flood or severe weather event, emergency services and your local government may use an Emergency Alert to send a warning message to your home or mobile phone. The message will tell you what's happening, how to stay safe, and where to get more information.

But don't wait to get an Emergency Alert before you act. Make an emergency plan and stock an emergency kit before a disaster strikes, and always tune in to warnings.
