Don't share chargers, even if the plug fits. Using the wrong charger can start a fire.

If there's a fire in your home, get out and stay out.



Never go back into a burning building.

Does your home have smoke alarms?



If your clothes catch fire, don't run.




If there is a fire at home, Blazer's meeting place is the mailbox.



Pick a meeting place far away from the house. Yours might be the bottom of the driveway or the big tree across the street.

When there's smoke in the air, get down low and go, go, go.



Smoke makes it hard to see and breathe, so Blazer crawls on the ground to get out. Draw smoke above Blazer.

If there's a fire, don't hide. Shout! Let others know where you are.






Bushy is a Rural Fire Service Queensland volunteer and will help you learn about bushfire safety.
